Daniela Martinez noted that second floor floorplan has been redesigned to accommodate new furniture, lower shelving and creating a blueprint for teen space. The furniture will be purchased as part of the ALA COVID Relief Fund Grant. The Maywood Library is the only Midwest library to have been awarded the \$30,000 grant. Daniela partnered with Dominican University. In fact, Daniela Martinez and our Library are featured in Dominican University's video. Daniela also partnered with the zoo in a virtual program. As of July, the Library has partnered with Beanstalk, an online site and mobile app for tracking reading and offering prizes. Libby and Overdrive are coming soon. Virtual programs, craft kits and story times continue. The online stories are very popular. Tie Dye Day and Family Game Night were scheduled in July with good attendance. Daniela also attended a Webinar on Pre-school Outreach Program.

Jori Daniels had one virtual program in August. One of the two planned outdoor activities had to be cancelled due to inclement weather. The PI presentation had to be re-scheduled because the presenter came down with COVID. The program will be re-scheduled for a later date. Last month's Grab and Go Kits went very well. Cleaning up our catalog continues. Jori participated in two Webinars: one on digital resources and one about libraries and the coronavirus. During August Daniela, Marcia and Jori will re-train for the required annual passport training. As of September 1st, we will have Kanapy. There are over 100 Tic Tok followers on our website.

Stan Huntington distributed a list of the board members addresses and phone numbers. Due to some recent library e-mail problems, Marcia Burton is advising us to check our Inbox and Spam folders until further notice.
